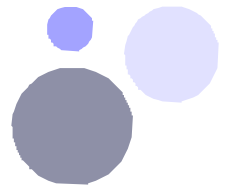

sample of recent 'unique programs'

the spastic centre: Y2Y created and facilitated the inaugural NSW Young People with a Disability YOUTH FORUM called *fusion*. The forum focussed on ability, inspiration and joining the new youth council called the Y-Connection which are set to start the first website dedicated to young people with a disability.

hornsby shire council: Y2Y created and facilitated their National Youth Week Forum that brought together local young people and councillors. The forum focused on ways to give young people a voice at a local level.

leichhardt municipal council: Y2Y created and facilitated an 8-week young women's program called *atomic*. The group met each Friday afternoon and explored different tools for success for young girls today, such as study skills, creating opportunities, and career choices.

blueprint: A national workshop & case study project to educate, recognise and promote enterprising young people in Australian communities, in collaboration with the International Young Professionals Foundation and the Foundation for Young Australians.

young mothers enterprise project: A series of four workshops over two locations to build a toolbox of enterprise skills and the independent earning capacity of young parents.

enya mentoring project: A three month mentoring program for enterprising young people.
